

Directions to Lawrence County 911 / EMS Office / Sheriff's CCW Office Emergency Management Agency / LEPC / Emergency Operations Center

Address: 515 Park Avenue Ironton, OH 45638

Caution: A GPS generally can get you to the correct exit but might NOT provide correct directions to the agency address.

From East (Gallipolis, OH; Huntington, WV; Ashland, KY)

Follow U.S. 52 west to the State Route 93 Exit, a.k.a. Downtown exit / Jackson. (You will see McDonald's arches to the right) Exit right and circle around. At the traffic signal turn right. You will then be on Park Avenue. Travel straight several blocks to the traffic signal at 6th Street. (Advance Auto Parts, then Dickess Auto Repair will be on your right) If you look ahead toward the "one-o'clock" position, you will see several antenna towers on the building just ahead. EMA / 911 offices are in that flat roof / red brick building. Turn right onto 6th Street (one way street) to find a parking space on 6th Street or turn right on 6th and go one block to Center Street, turn left to find parking on Center St. The Emergency Operations Center is in the rear, the one-story part of the 911 / EMA Building. To access the EOC, find the alley between Park and Center Streets behind the EMA / 911 building. Across the alley from the big brown Rumpke dumpster, you will see the sidewalk between the EMA building and a yellow brick building (the Sheriff's Office and jail). Enter at the first door / first set of steps, or travel up the ramp and ring the bell for entry.

From West (Portsmouth, OH, Greenup, KY)

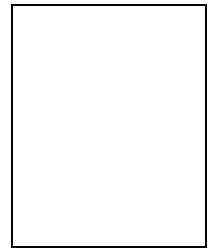
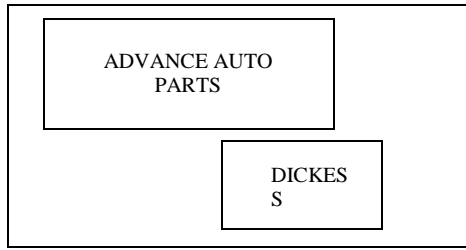
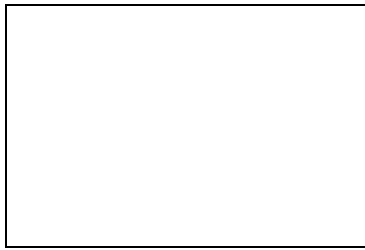
Follow U.S. 52 east to the State Route 93 Exit of U.S. 52, a.k.a. Downtown exit / Jackson. (You will see McDonald's arches on your left) Exit right and at the bottom of the ramp, turn right. You will then be on Park Avenue. Travel straight several blocks to the traffic signal at 6th Street. (Advance Auto Parts then Dickess Auto Repair will be on your right) If you look ahead toward the "one-o'clock" position, you will see several antenna towers on the building just ahead. EMA / 911 offices are in that flat-roof / red brick building. Turn right onto 6th Street (one way street) to find a parking space on 6th Street or turn right on 6th and go one block to Center Street, turn left to find parking on Center St. The EMA Emergency Operations Center is in the rear, the one-story part of the 911 / EMA Building. To access the EOC, find the alley between Park and Center Streets behind the EMA / 911 building. From North on Ohio Route 93 (Jackson / Jackson, OH; Vinton County, etc).

Follow Ohio Route 93 south to Ironton. Once you pass under the four-lane U.S. 52 bridges you will be on Park Avenue. Travel straight several blocks to the traffic signal at 6th Street. (Advanced Auto Parts then Dickess Auto Repair will be on your right) If you look ahead toward the "one-o'clock" position, you will see several antenna towers on the building just ahead. EMA / 911 offices are in that flat-roof / red brick building. Turn right onto 6th Street (one way street) to find a parking space on 6th Street or turn right on 6th and go one block to Center Street, turn left to find parking on Center St. The EMA Emergency Operations Center is in the rear, the one-story part of the 911 / EMA Building. To access the EOC, find the alley between Park and Center Streets behind the EMA / 911 building.
